Henshaws Arts & Crafts Centre in Knaresborough and International Service are joining forces to host an exciting day of global arts activities for young people. As with all activities run at the centre, the day will be fully inclusive for young people aged 5-16 of all abilities.

During the day (10.00am to 3.00pm) you'll be working with professional artists to paint, print and create art from around the world as part of the Same Difference global arts project. Trained staff and volunteers will be on hand throughout the day. Parents/guardians/carers are welcome to come along and watch and/or support their child.

As demand for places is expected to be very high, places will be allocated on a first come first served basis.

The cost for the day is just £5 per child including materials!
